

MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

The annual fee for membership in the Vintage Thunderbird Club of Indiana is \$15. This covers all members in the family. These dues entitle the member to a VTCIn Membership card, and member items including a current roster of the membership. Each member will also receive a copy of the clubs monthly newsletter "Bird Droppings", delivered to their home by first class mail. Current members enjoy full voting privileges at meetings and are eligible to hold club offices.

Annual dues renewals are payable by December 31st, and cover a full 12 months. Those who join after September 1st, will have a fee of \$15, which covers full membership through the following year.

VTCIn is a not for profit organization. All dues collected are used to defray the costs involved in operating the club, publication of the newsletter and cover the costs for some club activities.

INTERNATIONAL AFFILIATION

The Vintage Thunderbird Club of Indiana (VTCIn) is the SANCTIONED Indiana Chapter of the Vintage Thunderbird Club International. VTCI membership spans the globe and serves as the guiding force to bring vintage Thunderbird owners together. As a member you will enjoy their bi-monthly publication, "The SCOOP". Each issue is packed with stories about our cars, technical information, and restoration tips. Each year VTCI sponsors both regional meets as well as a national convention. Members and their families are urged to participate at all levels. With over 4000 members, VTCI is the oldest car club in the U.S. devoted entirely to the Ford Thunderbird.

VTCI dues are \$30 per year. This is a family membership.

The Vintage Thunderbird Club of Indiana strongly supports the efforts of the International Club and we encourage all of our members to participate in both the Regional meets, usually held somewhere in the midwest, and the National meet, which is rotated throughout the 6 regions of the United States.
